Library Cards

Crowley residents may obtain a library card at no cost with valid proof of residence (i.e. a current utility bill) and picture ID. Those who live outside city limits may purchase a non-resident card for an *annual* fee of \$15 for the first member and \$10 for each additional family member after that.
