SUBJECT: Discuss and consider approving FY 2020-21 Budget Amendment #1 for EDC

Operating Budget.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

This budget amendment includes several items. The first is landscaping design to be eligible for another Green Ribbon Grant. The cost for Pacheco Koch to design this is \$7,500. When the lease was executed for Redline (320 E. Main), the remaining fee due to the broker was \$52,500. The taxes on all the buildings owned by the EDC are estimated to be \$114,205. The businesses are paying NNN to pay for these taxes and the revenue is included in the Rental Income. The cost of the finish out for 320 E. Main is \$156,278 for the 2020-21 year.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Total cost of all the amendments is \$330,483. The remaining revenues over expenditures is \$9,950.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff respectfully recommends approving FY 2020-21 Budget amendment #1.
