MINUTES OF THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION BOARD OF DIRECTORS HELD Monday, April 5, 2021.

The Economic Development Corporation Board of Directors met on Monday, April 5, 2021, at 6:00p.m. in the City Council Chambers, 201 East Main Street, Crowley City Hall, Crowley, Texas.

CALL TO ORDER/ ROLL CALL

Vice President Carl Weber III called the Session to order for the Economic Development Corporation at 6:01 p.m. City Secretary Carol Konhauser called roll and noted a quorum was present.

EDC BUSINESS

1. Discuss and consider approving the minutes from the EDC meeting held on March 4, 2021.

Member Jim McDonald made the motion to approve the minutes as presented. second by Member Alex Hogan, the EDC Board of Directors voted unanimously to approve the motion as presented. Motion carried 5-0.

2. Discuss and consider authorizing the repair of the roof of the EDC building located at 320 East Main.

City Manager Robert Loftin began by explaining that the roof on the City owned building located at 320 W Main St, which houses House of Air and the soon to open Redline Athletics has had leaking issues. Most recently, the expansion joint where the building was expanded, is separating, which created another leak. He detailed how the water damage had leaked and ruined several of House of Air's televisions. Additionally, he added that the City had contacted TML and attempted to file an insurance claim, but it was determined that the leak is not from damage and the roof is simply old. Mr Loftin also explained that Redline Athletics is concerned that there would water damage on their gymnasium flooring. Staff received three quotes to repair the roof. Quick Roofing submitted the lowest and offered the best options for approximately \$265,501.72. Additionally, Mr Loftin added that it is recommended the City replace the downspouts. There are 7-8 downspouts on the building and they cost \$175.00 each.

Asst City Manager/Finance Director Lori Watson explained that the TIRZ reimbursed the EDC \$500,000 for the construction of Municipal Way. This extra money is what staff is recommending using to fund the parking lot design approved at the last meeting and this roofing expense.

Member Jesse Johnson made the motion to approve the roof installation quoted by Quick Roofing in the amount of \$265,501.72 along with an additional \$1,225.00 for the downspouts; second by Member Alex Hogan. The EDC Board of Directors voted 5-0 to approve the motion as presented. Motion carried 5-0.

SUBJECT: Discuss and consider approving FY 2020-21 Budget Amendment #2 for EDC

Operating Budget.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

This budget amendment includes the contracts previously approved by the board on April 5, 2021. The first is for the engineering and design of the parking for downtown for \$63,500. The second is for the roof replacement for 320 E. Main for \$270,000.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The remaining revenues over expenditures is \$9,950. The amount that will come from fund balance is \$323,550. The EDC will have an unencumbered fund balance of \$746,300 after this amendment. This amount is after removing the upcoming bond payments due in August.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff respectfully recommends approving FY 2020-21 Budget amendment #2.

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BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

Pursuant to the City of Crowley Code of Ordinances, Section 2-137, the Board shall elect, from among its members, officers to serve as President and Vice-president for a 1-yr term ending Sep 30 of each year. A vacancy on the Board shall be filled for the unexpired term by the Board. For the current term, the Board President is listed as Christine Gilbreath and the Vice President is Carl Weber III. Due to a vacancy, it is now necessary to appoint a new President and Vice President for the remainder of the term ending Sep 2021. It is typical of other boards for the Vice-President to move up to the President position and a new Vice-President is selected.
