#### **BACKGROUND:**

The Crime Control and Prevention District Board of Directors adopted the FY2023-24 budget on June 1, 2023. During the city budget process, the police department requested an additional traffic officer to continue efforts to patrol and prevent accidents. Currently, 60% of the IT Administrator's salary is included in the CCPD budget. An additional IT position was added this year to assist in keeping up with the needs and demands of the city. The police department has the largest workload and demand on this department. The attached budget includes 60% of the IT salaries and the additional Traffic Officer.

The amendment to the Johnson County Communications Contract for radios was received after the CCPD budget was adopted. The prior year rate was \$24.20 per radio per month. The amended contract removed the dispatch fee and decreased the monthly cost to \$16.64 per radio.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff respectfully requests approval of FY2023-24 Budget Amendment #1.

#### **FISCAL INFORMATION:**

The total increase in personnel costs is \$144,538. The decrease in the cost of the radio contract equals \$13,245. The prior revenue over expenditures was \$605,286. After the amendment, the net revenue over expenditures is \$473,993.
