This document is provided to assist established businesses with questions or concerns regarding "Annual Fire & Life Safety Inspections". The Crowley Fire Marshal's office must conduct annual fire & life safety inspections to comply with the adopted International Fire Code and ISO mandates. All building owners, business owners and/or businesses leasing space must comply with this requirement.

These inspection checklists are wide ranging in attempt to account for an entire building, a small tenant space or a specific business type. Not all items contained in these lists will necessarily apply to every possible business.

## Top Reasons Fire & Life Safety Inspections Fail

- 1. Exit lights and emergency lights fail to operate on battery power
- 2. Extension cords are used in lieu of permanent power
- 3. Misuse of multi-plug adaptor devices
- 4. Storage is too close to sprinkler heads or ceilings
- 5. Storage too close to electrical panels
- 6. Emergency exit doors are locked or obstructed
- 7. Combustible materials stored too close to water heaters and/or heating units
- 8. Combustible & flammable liquids not stored in proper cabinets
- 9. Missing Building address and/or suite address on front & back doors
- 10. Fire lane markings not maintained
- 11. Sprinkler suppression systems & fire alarm systems past due for annual inspections
- 12. Kitchen hood suppression systems and Alternative suppression systems past due for annual inspections
- 13. Loose electrical wiring, breakers missing from panels creating gaps, missing electrical box covers
- 14. Knox Boxes not maintained with Keys & identification tags (all necessary keys to gain access into the structure & internal spaces, elevator and fire alarm control units) for all Knox Boxes
