- Make recommendations to the City Council with regard to the library budget
- Review and recommend rules, procedures, and ordinances relating to the management of a public library program
- Solicit or receive gifts or requests
- Submit on Oct. 1 of each year a progress report to the City Council summarizing its activities and accomplishments
