RECYCLING COLLECTION DAY: WEDNESDAY

TIME: Please have the Waste Connections recycling bins out at the curb before 7:00am.

Recycling may be picked up anytime between 7 am to 5 pm. Recycling bins must be loaded so as to weigh no more than fifty (50) pounds. Only the green Waste Connections bins will be collected. Please do not use any other containers provided by previous service companies.

What Can Be Recycled

Metal & Aluminum Cans: Rinse and drain your metal food cans composed of tin, steel or aluminum and place loose in your bin. It is not necessary to remove the label, but please remove the lids and all food waste.

Plastic: Rinse and place soft drink liter bottles and milk jugs in your bin. You may now also include #1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 7 plastics. Shampoo bottles are accepted. **Please remove all caps.**

Glass: Includes clear, brown, and green bottles. **Please remove all caps.**

Newspaper, Magazines & Catalogs:

Place Dry newspaper, magazines, catalogs and other paper items such as mail, paper bags or other paper in the bottom of your bin. Slick or glossy inserts are accepted with the newspaper. Please don't put out on a rainy day. Be sure that the newspaper is secured so that it doesn't fly away.

What Cannot Be Recycled

Scrap metal and metal other than food and beverage cans, aluminum foil, mirrors, window glass, plate glass, ceramics or safety glass such as windshields, large plastic buckets, butter tubs or containers with openings as large as the container, no plastic bottles that have contained oil or petroleum by-products, paper products such as notebook paper or diapers.

Overflow Items: Recycling will only be picked up if it is in the recycling bin. If you need a second bin, please come by the Water Department and pick one up. There will be a one-time \$5 charge for an extra bin.

TIME: PLEASE HAVE ALL GARBAGE OUT AT THE CURB BEFORE 7:00 A.M.

Garbage will be picked up any-time between 7 am and 5 pm. Trash must be in bags and loaded so as to weigh no more than fifty (50) pounds per bag or can. Waste Connections is not responsible for loose trash or damage to cans or containers.

What will be collected

Garbage: Refuse or vegetable matter (as from a kitchen or food processing facility), cans, bottles, sacks, clothes, and any other household waste.

Trash: All household waste other than garbage such as: grass, yard clippings, leaves, weeds, or debris.

Brush: Waste Connections will collect brush tied and bundled no larger than (48) inches by (24) inches. Bundles cannot weigh more than 50lbs each and there is a maximum of 4 bundles per pick up. Collection of brush is limited to amount generated by the individual resident. Brush and tree limbs generated by a landscaping service or tree trimming company will not be collected.

Bulky Waste: The following is considered bulky waste: refrigerators and freezers with a certification report that the CFC's have been removed by a certified technician, washing machines, hot water heaters, dishwashers, stoves and other household appliances and furnishings generated by the resident.

What Cannot Be Collected

The following will not be collected: asbestos, construction & demolition debris, tires, gasoline and oil based products such as used car parts, paint, fecal material, contaminated soils, MSW incinerator ash, sewage treatment sludge, industrial sludge, pathological waste, pollution control waste and any other product classified or labeled as hazardous.

Annual Free Dump Day

Each resident is allowed one free dump day at the Waste Connections Type IV C&D Landfill from the period of October 1 – September 30. The dump site is located at 4144 Dick Price Rd., Ft Worth, Texas. Each resident must present at the gate proof of residency with a current water bill. Type of waste is limited one level pick up bed full of construction and demolition material, yard waste and fencing. No dump or containers containing liquid or classified as special/hazardous waste will be accepted.
