**SUBJECT:** Discuss and receive guidance on the Continuation Referendum for the Crowley

Crime Control and Prevention District.

#### BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The Crowley CCPD was originally voted on and created in 2005 for a 5-year period. In 2010, a continuation referendum was ordered and the citizens of Crowley voted in favor of continuing the CCPD for an additional 10 years. The district is set to be dissolved in 2020. In order to keep the district from automatically dissolving, a referendum continuation must be held.

The statute provides that the CCPD board may order a referendum to continue the district "on its own motion by a majority vote of its members" [Section 363.251 (b)]. Additionally, the statute provides that the "governing body of the municipality that created the district may specify the number of years for which a district should be continued" [Sec. 363.2515 (a)], and that a "district may be continued under Subsection (a) only for 5, 10, 15, or 20 years." [Sec. 363.2515 (b)].

Lastly, the City Secretary received an application for a Local Option Petition, and if the petitioner is able to obtain the required number of signatures, the City Secretary anticipates holding an election on the Nov 5, 2019 Uniform Election Date. If there is to be a special election in Nov 2019, it is staff's recommendation that the CCPD order a continuation referendum for Nov 5, 2019. If there will not be a Nov 2019 election, it will be required to hold a May 2020 election in order to continue the CCPD.

Estimated date Petition to be picked up by petitioner: May 6, 2019 Date Petition will be due back to City Secretary: Jul 5, 2019 Date Local Option Election must be ordered: before Aug 19, 2019 Date CCPD Election must be ordered: before Oct 2, 2019

Date Election Order for Local Option and CCPD must be published in newspaper: Oct 8, 2019 (and Oct

16, 2019 for CCPD only)

#### **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

The cost of an election is estimated to be approximately \$9,000.

Staff requests the boards input on when and if they would like to order a continuation referendum and for the period of time they would recommend for the continuation.

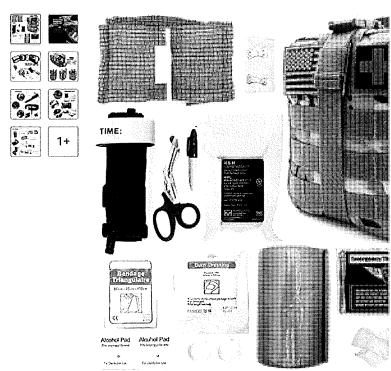

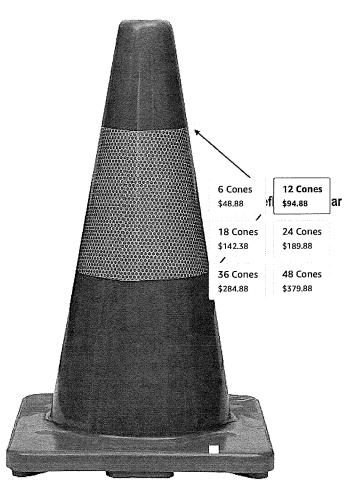

### Alliance for Children

Alliance For Children partners with 26 Tarrant County law enforcement agencies, the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services, Cook Children's\* Medical Center and the Tarrant County Criminal District Attorney's Office. All of these agencies work together at Alliance For Children centers to reduce trauma to child abuse victims during an investigation and to improve their agencies' responses to children who are often frightened and hurting. As a result of the collaboration, investigators and detectives are able to complete investigations in a more timely fashion, cases are stronger for prosecution, and children and protective caregivers are more likely to benefit from available services.

#### Multidisciplinary Team Coordination

Alliance For Children is the children's advocacy center serving all of Tarrant County. Since 1992, over 54,000 children have benefited from Alliance For Children's teamed investigations and coordinated approach. Alliance For Children is a nonprofit organization that operates child-friendly centers located in Arlington, Fort Worth, Hurst and Lakeside.

Forensic Interviews-The Alliance For Children Forensic Interview Team assists Tarrant County law enforcement and the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services by conducting specialized investigative interviews of children.

Clinical Services- Alliance For Children offers both individual and group counseling services free of charge to confirmed victims of child abuse and their protective family members.

Our specially trained team of Family Advocates helps navigate children and their protective family members through the overwhelming process of dealing with a case of child abuse. From initial outcry all the way through prosecution, our Family Advocates are there to help families understand the process and successfully access needed resources in our community.

Families are referred to our program through our partners in the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services and local law enforcement agencies.

All services are provided at no cost to the family and can include:

- Case management
- Resource referrals
- Court preparation
- Financial assistance
- Emergency needs
- Assistance completing Crimes Victims' Compensation applications
