## BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The Crowley Police Department presents the FY 2023-24 Annual Budget for review and consideration by the Crime Control and Prevention District Board.

## **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

The proposed revenues for the 2023-24 year are projected to be \$1,378,997. The upcoming bond payments total \$270,968. The proposed recurring expenditures are projected to be \$494,876. One-time costs for equipment and other fees are estimated at \$7,867. Total Expenditures are estimated to be \$773,711. This will leave a surplus of \$605,286.

Set the date for a Public Hearing to discuss and approve the final budget for June 1, 202,3 at 6:00 pm at Crowley City Hall.
