

# Candidate Qualifications

## Qualifications for Candidacy & Holding Office

City of Crowley Charter, Article IV Municipal Elections, Section 4.04 Qualifications for Candidacy and Holding Office states:

- Each member of the City Council, including the mayor, shall meet the following qualifications:
  - Be a registered voter of the city
  - Have resided in the city for one (1) year before the date of the election
  - Continue residency in the city during the term of office
  - Not hold more than one public-elected office
  - Not hold an appointed office of the city excluding boards, committees, and commissions
  - Be at least 21 years of age
  - Not have been determined mentally incompetent by a final judgment of a court
  - Not have been finally convicted of a felony from which the person has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities
- No candidate may file for more than one office or position number per election.
