RECYCLING COLLECTION DAY: **WEDNESDAY**

TIME: Please have the Waste Connections recycling bin out at the curb before 7 a.m. Recycling may be picked up anytime between 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Recycling bins must be loaded so as to weigh no more than fifty (50) pounds. Only the green Waste Connections bin will be collected. Please do not use any other containers provided by previous service companies.

What Can Be Recycled
Metal & Aluminum Cans: Rinse and drain your metal food cans composed of tin, steel or aluminum and place loose in your bin. It is not necessary to remove the label, but please remove the lid and all food waste.
Plastic: Rinse and place soft drink like bottles and milk jugs in your bin. You may not use other plastic like #1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 7 plastics. Shampoo bottles are accepted. Please remove all caps.
Glass: Includes clear, brown, and green bottles. Please remove all caps.
Newspaper, Magazines & Catalogs:
Place Dry newspaper, magazines, catalogs and other paper items such as mail, paper bags or other paper in the bottom of your bin. Stick or glossy inserts are accepted with the newspaper. Please don't put out on a rainy day. Be sure that the newspaper is secured so that it doesn't fly away.
What Cannot Be Recycled
Scrap metal and metal other than food and beverage cans, aluminum foil, mirrors, window glass, plate glass, ornate or safety glass such as windshield, large plastic buckets, butter tubs or containers with openings as large as the container, no plastic bottles that have contained oil or petroleum by products, paper products such as cardboard paper or diapers.
Overflow Bins: Recycling will only be picked up if it is in the recycling bin. If you need a second bin, please come by the Waste Department and pick one up. There will be a one-time \$5 charge for an extra bin.

GARBAGE COLLECTION DAY: **MTWTFSS**

TIME: PLEASE HAVE ALL GARBAGE OUT AT THE CURB BEFORE 7:00 A.M. Garbage will be picked up any time between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Trash must be in bags and loaded so as to weigh no more than fifty (50) pounds per bag or can. Waste Connections is not responsible for loose trash or damage to cans or containers.

What will be collected
Garbage: Refuse or vegetable matter (as from a kitchen or food processing facility), cans, bottles, socks, clothes, and any other household waste.
Trash: All household waste other than garbage such as grass, yard clippings, leaves, weeds, or debris.
Bulky: Waste Connections will collect bulky trash and hauled as large as 48 inches by 36 inches. Bulky items cannot weigh more than 70 lbs each and there is a maximum of 4 loads per pick up. Collection of bulky is limited to amount generated by the individual resident. Brush and tree limbs generated by a landscaping service or tree trimming company will not be collected.
Appliances: The following is considered bulky waste: refrigerators and freezers with a certification report that the CFC's have been removed by a certified technician, washing machines, hot water heaters, dishwashers, stoves and other household appliances and furnishings generated by the resident.
What Cannot Be Collected
The following will not be collected: asbestos, construction & demolition debris, tires, gas-type and oil based products such as used car parts, paint, flammable, contaminated soils, HAZWASTE materials such, sewage treatment sludge, industrial sludge, pathological waste, petroleum based waste and any other product classified or labeled as hazardous.
Allowed Free Drop Day
Each resident is allowed one free drop day at the Waste Connections Type IV C&D Landfill from the period of October 1 - September 30. The drop site is located at 4044 Dick Price Rd., Ft Worth, Texas. Each resident must present at the gate proof of residency with a current voter ID. Type of waste is limited one level pick up and full of construction and demolition material, yard waste and fencing. No dump or containers containing liquid or classified as special/hazardous waste will be accepted.

The City of Crowley contracts solid waste collection and recycling with Waste Connections for all residential customers. Commercial customers can contact and select a service provider of their choice.

Collection Day

Please have all garbage out at the curb by 7 a.m. Garbage will be picked up anytime between 7-5 p.m. Bags must be loaded so as to weigh no more than 50 pounds per bag or trash bin.

*Waste Connections is not responsible for loose trash or damage to cans or containers.

Collectible Items

Garbage

- Bottles
- Cans
- Clothes
- Other household waste

Trash

- Clippings
- Debris

Brush

- All brush tied and bundled no larger than 48 inches by 24 inches
- Loose or unbundled brush will not be picked up
- Collection of the brush is limited to the amount generated by the individual resident.

Note: Brush and tree limbs generated by a landscaping service or tree trimming company will **not** be collected.

Bulky Waste

- Bulk pickup items may be put out on the second service day of the week. Up to two (2) cubic yards can be set out on the 2nd pick up day of each week. See picture below of an estimate of what 2 cubic yards' measures.
- * Brush must be cut to a length of 4 (four) feet or less, bundled (tied) together, stacked neatly; and each bundle must not weigh more than 50 (fifty) pounds.
- All items must be in front of residence or side of residence with 5 feet of roadway/curb, 4 feet from any stationary object and not under any overhanging objects like trees and/or power lines.

Items must be set out on the service day before 7 a.m. (Any items on vacant lots will not be serviced).

- Dishwashers
 - Water heaters
 - Other household appliances and furniture
 - Refrigerators and freezers with a certification report that the CFCs have been removed by a certified technician
 - Gas cans (have to be completely empty and washed out with no cap or nozzle on it)
 - Stoves
 - Washing machines
 - Toilets (empty with base and tank in two separate pieces)
