Can I just participate in a TAG project here and there without joining TAG?


Sometimes you can depending on what is shared in our teen volunteer email list. But the bulk of the planning and implementation happens during the TAG meetings.

How do I stay in TAG? Joining is easy. Staying in TAG requires a little more work.

- Attend as many of the official monthly meetings as possible
- Ability to work well independently and with the rest of TAG
- You don't need experience to join, but you do need to be able to attend meetings and come in for extra projects
- It's OK if you go on vacation or are less involved one month than the other. Missing here and there is fine, but not for a lengthy period
- If you don't know, join and test it out
